

Policy 1150: Commendations And Awards

To encourage community involvement in district programs and activities, the Governing Board may publicly recognize and commend parents/guardians, community members, businesses, and organizations that make outstanding contributions or provide longstanding service to the district or district students.

Any Governing Board member, employee, parent/guardian, student, or community member may recommend an individual or organization for Governing Board recognition. They shall submit to the Superintendent or designee the name of the individual or organization and a description of the outstanding contribution or service.

At the Governing Board's discretion, the Governing Board may present a letter of recognition, Board resolution, plaque, or other award at a public Board meeting or may hold a reception or informal recognition activity. The Governing Board also may designate a day, week, or month for special recognition of volunteers.

The Governing Board encourages similar forms of recognition for achievement or services as part of school-level commendation programs.
