

Bylaw 9224: Oath Or Affirmation

Prior to entering upon the duties of ~~their office, all Board of Education members~~ ~~the office of a~~ **Governing Board member or exercising any function of a Board member**, each Board member shall take the oath or affirmation required by law. (California Constitution, Article 20, Section 3; Government Code 1360)

The oath **or affirmation** may be administered and certified by a Board member, ~~the~~ secretary or assistant secretary to the **Governing** Board, ~~the~~ Superintendent, ~~deputy or assistant superintendent, principal, or County~~ **the County Superintendent of Schools, the Superintendent of Schools** **Public Instruction**, or any other person authorized in Education Code 60 **or Government Code 1225**.

The executed oath shall be filed with the County Clerk. (Government Code 1363)
