

INDEPENDENT CONSULTANT AGREEMENT FOR SERVICES
(Student Nurse/Arizona State University)

This Independent Consultant Agreement for Services ("Agreement") is made and entered into as of March 13, 2026, by and between the Redwood City School District ("District") and The Arizona Board of Regents, a body corporate for and on behalf of Arizona State University ("Consultant"), (together, "Parties").

The District is in need of Consultant's services and/or advice, and Consultant is free from the control and direction of District in connection with the performance of the Services (as defined below), both under the Agreement and in fact; Consultant's Services are outside the usual course of District's business; and Consultant is customarily engaged in an independently established trade, occupation, or business of the same nature as that involved in the Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration for the agreements provided below and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy which are hereby acknowledged, the Parties agree as follows:

AGREEMENT TERMS

1. **Services.** Consultant shall provide only the services as described in **Exhibit A**, attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference ("Services").
2. **Term.** Consultant shall commence providing services under this Agreement on August 12, 2026 and will diligently perform as required and complete performance by Jun 30, 2027 unless this Agreement is terminated and/or otherwise cancelled prior to that time.
3. **Validity of Agreement.** This Agreement shall not be a valid contract until it is executed by both Parties, and approved or ratified by the District's Board of Trustees. Any Services performed by Consultant in advance of Board approval or ratification will be provided at the Consultant's risk.
4. **Submittal of Documents.** Consultant shall not commence the Services under this Agreement until Consultant has submitted and District has approved the certificate(s) and affidavit(s), and the endorsement(s) of insurance required as indicated below:

Materials. Unless otherwise agreed to by the Parties pursuant to a separate agreement, Consultant shall furnish, at its own expense, all labor, materials, equipment, supplies and other items necessary to complete the Services to be provided pursuant to this Agreement.

5. **Independent Contractor.** Consultant, in the performance of this Agreement, shall be and act as an independent contractor. Consultant represents and warrants that: (i) Consultant is free from the control and direction of District in connection with the performance of the Services, both under the Agreement and in fact; (ii) Consultant's Services are outside the usual course of District's business; and (iii) Consultant is customarily engaged in an independently established trade, occupation, or business of the same nature as that involved in the Services.

Consultant understands and agrees that it and all of its employees shall not be considered officers, employees, agents, partner, or joint venture of District, and are not entitled to benefits of any kind or nature normally provided employees of District and/or to which District's employees are normally entitled, including, but not limited to, State Unemployment Compensation or Workers' Compensation. Consultant shall assume full responsibility for payment of all federal, state and local taxes or contributions, including unemployment insurance, social security and income taxes with respect to Consultant's employees.

6. **Performance of Services.**

- 6.1. **Standard of Care.** Consultant represents that Consultant has the qualifications and ability to perform the Services in a professional manner, without the advice, control or supervision of District. Consultant's services will be performed, findings obtained, reports and recommendations prepared in accordance with generally and currently accepted principles and practices of its profession for services to California school districts.
- 6.2. **Certificates/Permits/Licenses/Registration.** Consultant and all Consultant's employees or agents shall secure and maintain in force such certificates, permits, licenses and registration as are required by law in connection with the furnishing of Services pursuant to this Agreement. By signing this Agreement, Consultant represents and warrants that Consultant and all Consultant's employees or agents have obtained and completed all certificates, permits, licenses and registration as are required by law in connection with the furnishing of Services.
- 6.3. **Safety and Security.** Consultant is responsible for maintaining safety in the performance of this Agreement. Consultant shall be responsible to ascertain from the District the rules and regulations pertaining to safety, security, and driving on school grounds, particularly when children are present.
- 6.4. **Meetings.** If desired and agreed upon, Consultant and District may participate in regular meetings on at least a monthly basis to discuss strategies, timetables, implementations of services, and any other issues deemed relevant to the operation of Consultant's performance of Services.
- 6.5. **District Approval.** The Services provided herein must meet the approval of District. District may evaluate Consultant in any way District is entitled pursuant to applicable law, including, without limitation, announced and unannounced observance of Consultant, Consultant's employee(s), and/or subconsultant(s).
7. **Originality of Services.** If relevant and to the extent applicable to the Services, Consultant agrees that all technologies, formulae, procedures, processes, methods, writings, ideas, dialogue, compositions, recordings, teleplays and video productions prepared for, written for, or submitted to District and/or used in connection with this Agreement, shall be wholly original to Consultant and shall not be copied in whole or in part from any other source, except that submitted to Consultant by District as a basis for such services.
8. **Work Product.** If relevant and to the extent applicable to the Services, Consultant understands and agrees that all matters produced under this Agreement shall become the property of District and cannot be used without District's express written permission. District shall have all right, title and interest in said matters, including the right to secure and maintain the copyright, trademark and/or patent of said matter in the name of the District.
9. **Curriculum.** If relevant and to the extent applicable to the Services, all original curricular materials provided in conjunction with Consultant's Services must be authorized for use by the District only and remain exclusively the intellectual property of the authors.
10. **Termination.**
- 10.1. **For Convenience by District.** District may, at any time, with or without reason, terminate this Agreement and compensate Consultant only for Services satisfactorily rendered to the date of termination. Written notice by District shall be sufficient to stop further performance of Services by Consultant. Notice shall be deemed given when received by Consultant or no later than three (3) calendar days after the day of mailing, whichever is sooner. The Parties may decide to agree upon a mutual

termination date if immediate stoppage of Services is not practical or District requires additional time to find a replacement.

- 10.2. **With Cause by Either Party.** Either Party may terminate this Agreement upon giving of written notice of intention to terminate for cause. Cause shall include:

10.2.1. material violation by either Party of any term of this Agreement; or

10.2.2. any act by Consultant exposing District to liability to others for personal injury or property damage.

Written notice by the terminating Party shall contain the reasons for such intention to terminate and unless within ten (10) business days after that notice the condition or violation shall cease, or satisfactory arrangements for the correction thereof be made, this Agreement shall upon the expiration of the ten (10) business days cease and terminate. In the event of termination with cause by District, District may secure the required Services from another Consultant. If the expense, fees, and/or costs to District exceed the cost of providing the Service pursuant to this Agreement, Consultant shall immediately pay the excess expense, fees, and/or costs to District upon the receipt of District's notice of these expense, fees, and/or costs. The foregoing provisions are in addition to and not a limitation of any other rights or remedies available to the terminating Party.

- 10.3. Upon termination, if relevant and to the extent applicable to the Services, Consultant shall provide the District with all documents produced, maintained or collected by Consultant pursuant to this Agreement, whether or not such documents are final or draft documents.

11. **Indemnification.** Because CONSULTANT is a public Consultant, any indemnification, liability limitation, releases, or hold harmless provisions are limited as required by Arizona law, including Article 9, Sections 5 and 7 of the Arizona Constitution and ARS §§ 35-154 and 41-621. CONSULTANT's liability under any claim for indemnification is limited to claims for property damage, personal injury, or death to the extent caused by acts or omissions of CONSULTANT.

12. **Insurance.**

- 12.1. Consultant shall procure and maintain at all times it performs any portion of the Services the following insurance with minimum limits equal to the amount indicated below. To the extent reasonable, the Parties may negotiate these coverages and limits only upon the condition that they are approved by the District's risk manager.

- 12.1.1. **Commercial General Liability and Automobile Liability Insurance.** Commercial General Liability Insurance and Any Auto Automobile Liability Insurance that shall protect Consultant, District, and the State from all claims of bodily injury, property damage, personal injury, death, advertising injury, and medical payments arising performing any portion of the Services. (Form CG 0001 and CA 0001, or forms substantially similar, if approved by District.)

- 12.1.2. **Workers' Compensation and Employer's Liability Insurance.** Workers' Compensation Insurance and Employer's Liability Insurance for all of its employees performing any portion of the Services in accordance with provisions of section 3700 of the California Labor Code. If any class of employee or employees engaged in performing any portion of the Services under this Agreement are not protected under the Workers' Compensation Statute, adequate insurance coverage for the protection of any employee(s) not otherwise protected must be obtained before any of those employee(s) commence performing any portion of the Services. That policy shall provide employer's liability coverage per accident for bodily injury or disease. Consultant shall complete the Worker's Compensation Certificate attached hereto as **Exhibit C**.
- 12.1.3. **Professional Liability (Errors and Omissions).** If applicable to the Services, Professional Liability Insurance as appropriate to Consultant's profession, coverage to continue through completion of construction plus two (2) years thereafter.
- 12.1.4. **Abuse and Molestation Insurance.** Abuse and Molestation Insurance shall protect the Consultant and the District from all claims of bodily injury (including emotional distress), personal injury, or advertising injury because of sexual abuse, molestation, or exploitation arising out of negligent hiring, training, and supervising practices by Consultant.
- 12.2. **Proof of Insurance.** Consultant shall not commence performing any portion of the Services until all required insurance has been obtained and certificates indicating the required coverage have been delivered in duplicate to District and approved by District. Certificates and insurance policies shall include the following:
 - 12.2.1. Language stating in particular those insured, extent of insurance, location and operation to which insurance applies, expiration date, to whom cancellation and reduction notice will be sent, and length of notice period.
 - 12.2.2. An endorsement for each policy stating that coverage shall not be canceled except after thirty (30) days prior written notice by certified mail, return receipt requested, has been given to District.
 - 12.2.3. An endorsement stating that District and its Governing Board, agents, representatives, employees, trustees, officers, consultants, and volunteers are named additional insured under all policies except Workers' Compensation Insurance, Professional Liability, and Employer's Liability Insurance. Any failure to comply with reporting or other provisions of the policies including breaches of warranties shall not affect coverage provided to the Additional Insureds.
 - 12.2.4. An endorsement stating that Consultant's insurance policies shall be primary to any insurance or self-insurance maintained by District.
 - 12.2.5. An endorsement stating that there shall be a waiver of any subrogation against the District and its respective elected officials, officers, employees, agents, representatives, contractors, trustees, and volunteers.
 - 12.2.6. All policies except the Professional Liability, Workers' Compensation, and Employer's Liability Insurance Policies shall be written on an occurrence form.
 - 12.2.7. Consultant's insurance shall apply separately to each insured against whom claim is made or suit is brought, except with respect to the limits of the insurer's liability.
- 12.3. **Acceptability of Insurers.** Insurance is to be placed with insurers with a current A.M. Best's rating of no less than A: VII, unless otherwise acceptable to District.
- 12.4. Notwithstanding anything in this Agreement to the contrary, the District acknowledges that the Consultant is a state agency of the State of Arizona. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 41-621, the State of Arizona is self-insured for liability, property, and worker's compensation. Any liability of Consultant is subject to the provisions, limitations, and immunities of the Arizona Constitution and the Arizona Revised Statutes. Consultant shall provide and maintain throughout the term of this Agreement a program of self-insurance for its operations and personnel as required by Arizona law. The parties agree that this self-insurance satisfies any requirements for insurance under this Agreement.

1. **Compliance with Laws.** Consultant shall observe and comply with all rules and regulations of all federal, state, and local laws, ordinances and regulations. Consultant shall give all notices required by any law, ordinance, rule and regulation bearing on conduct of the Services as indicated or specified. If Consultant observes that any of the

Services required by this Agreement are at variance with any such laws, ordinance, rules or regulations, Consultant shall notify District, in writing, and, at the sole option of District, any necessary changes to the scope of the Services shall be made and this Agreement shall be appropriately amended in writing, or this Agreement shall be terminated effective upon Consultant's receipt of a written termination notice from District.

13. **Non-Discrimination.** The parties will comply with all applicable state and federal laws, rules, regulations, and executive orders governing equal employment opportunity, immigration, and nondiscrimination, including the Americans with Disabilities Act. The District is committed to providing equal opportunity for all individuals in education. By signing this Agreement, Consultant certifies that its programs, activities, and practices are free from discrimination.
14. **Conflict of Interest.** If within 3 years after the execution of this Agreement, District hires as an employee or agent any Consultant representative who was significantly involved in negotiating, securing, drafting, or creating this Agreement, then Consultant may cancel this Agreement as provided in Arizona Revised Statutes (ARS) § 38- 511.
15. **Arbitration in Superior Court.** Notice is hereby given of ARS § 12-133 and ARS § 12-1518.
16. **Failure of Legislature to appropriate.** In accordance with ARS § 35-154, if Consultant's performance under this Agreement depends on the appropriation of funds by the Arizona Legislature, and if the Legislature fails to appropriate the funds necessary for performance, then Consultant may provide written notice of this to District and cancel this Agreement without further obligation of Consultant. Appropriation is a legislative act and is beyond the control of Consultant.
17. **Privacy; Educational Records.** Student educational records are protected by the U.S. Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. § 1232g (FERPA). District will not require any Consultant students or employees to waive any privacy rights (including under FERPA or the European Union's General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)) as a condition for receipt of any educational services, and any attempt to do so will be void. District will comply with FERPA and will not access or make any disclosures of student educational records to third parties without prior notice to and consent from Consultant or as otherwise provided by law. If this Agreement contains a scope of work or other provision that requires or permits District to access or release any student records, then, for purposes of this Agreement only, Consultant designates District as a "school official" for Consultant under FERPA, as that term is used in FERPA and its implementing regulations. In addition, any access or disclosures of student educational records made by District or any District Parties must comply with Consultant's definition of legitimate educational purpose in SSM 107-01: Release of Student Information. If District violates the terms of this section, District will immediately provide notice of the violation to Consultant.
18. **Advertising, Publicity, Names and Marks.** District will not do any of the following, without, in each case, Consultant's prior written consent: (i) use any names, service marks, trademarks, trade names, logos, or other identifying names, domain names, or identifying marks of Consultant (Consultant Marks) for any reason, including online, advertising, or promotional purposes; (ii) issue a press release or public statement regarding this Agreement; or (iii) represent or imply any Consultant endorsement or support of any product or service in any public or private communication. Any permitted use of Consultant Marks must comply with Consultant's requirements, including using the ® indication of a registered mark.
19. **Environment of Respect.** Consultant prohibits all forms of discrimination, harassment and retaliation. To view Consultant's policy please see <https://www.asu.edu/aad/manuals/acd/acd401.html>. Title IX protects individuals from discrimination based on sex in any educational program or activity operated by recipients of federal financial assistance. As required by Title IX, Consultant does not discriminate on the basis of sex in the education programs or activities that we operate, including in admission and employment. Inquiries concerning the application of Title IX may be referred to the Title IX Coordinator or to the U.S. Department of Education, Assistant Secretary, or both. District, including its personnel, will (i) provide Consultant students and staff with an Environment of Respect, (ii) immediately provide notice to Consultant of any suspected violation of this section, and (iii) to the extent permitted by law, fully cooperate with Consultant to address any actual or suspected violation hereof.
20. **Fingerprinting.** Pursuant to Education Code Section 45125.1, prior to the commencement of any services by Consultant, Consultant shall require that it and any of its personnel (officers, principals, paid or unpaid employees, volunteers, agents, subtenants and subcontractors of Consultant) ("Consultant Personnel") who may interact with pupils outside the immediate supervision and control of the student's parent or guardian or a school employee, has a valid criminal records summary as described in Education Code Section 44237 on file with the District, and shall not permit any Consultant Personnel to provide services to the District until the California Department of Justice has determined that none of the Consultant Personnel has been convicted of a felony, as that term is defined in Education Code section 45122.1. The Fingerprinting/Criminal Background Investigation Certification attached hereto as **Exhibit D** must be completed and attached to this Agreement prior to Consultant's performing of any

portion of the Services. Consultant expressly acknowledges that the following conditions shall also apply to any work performed by Consultant Personnel while on a school site:

- 20.1. All site visits shall be arranged through the District;
 - 20.2. Consultant Personnel shall check in with the school office each day immediately upon arriving at the school site;
 - 20.3. Once at such location, Consultant Personnel shall not change locations without contacting the District;
 - 20.4. Consultant Personnel shall not use student restroom facilities; and
 - 20.5. If Consultant Personnel find themselves alone with a student, Consultant Personnel shall immediately contact the school office and request that a member of the school staff be assigned to the work location.
21. **Tuberculosis Certification.** The Tuberculosis Certification must be completed and attached to this Agreement for any person employed under contract in a certificated or classified position per Education Code Section 49406.
22. **No Rights in Third Parties.** This Agreement does not create any rights in, or inure to the benefit of, any third party except as expressly provided herein.

23. **Confidentiality.** All Consultant's agents, personnel, and employee(s) shall maintain the confidentiality of all information received in the course of performing the Services. Consultant's agents, personnel, and employee(s) understand that student records are confidential and agrees require students to comply with all state and federal laws concerning the maintenance and disclosure of student records. This requirement to maintain confidentiality shall extend beyond the termination of this Agreement.
24. **Notice.** Any notice required or permitted to be given under this Agreement shall be deemed to have been given, served, and received if given in writing and either personally delivered or deposited in the United States mail, registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt required, or sent by overnight delivery service, addressed as follows:

Any notice personally given or sent by electronic mail shall be effective upon receipt. Any notice sent by overnight delivery service shall be effective the business day next following delivery thereof to the overnight delivery service. Any notice given by mail shall be effective three (3) calendar days after deposit in the United States mail.

Disputes. In the event of a dispute between the parties as to performance of the Services, the interpretation of this Agreement, or payment or nonpayment for work performed or not performed, the parties shall attempt to resolve the dispute in good faith. Pending resolution of the dispute, Consultant agrees it will neither rescind the Agreement nor stop the performance of the Services, but will allow determination by the court having competent jurisdiction of the dispute. Disputes may be determined by mediation if mutually agreeable. , Notice of the demand for mediation of a dispute shall be filed in writing with the other party to the Agreement. The demand for mediation shall be made within a reasonable time after written notice of the dispute has been provided to the other party, but in no case longer than ninety (90) days after initial written notice.

Attorney's Fees/Costs. Consultant recognizes an obligation to pay attorneys' fees or costs only when assessed by a court of competent jurisdiction.

25. **Integration/Entire Agreement of Parties.** This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes all prior discussions, negotiations, and agreements, whether oral or written. This Agreement may be amended or modified only by a written instrument executed by both Parties.
26. **Waiver.** The waiver by either party of any breach of any term, covenant, or condition herein contained shall not be deemed to be a waiver of such term, covenant, condition, or any subsequent breach of the same or any other term, covenant, or condition herein contained.
27. **Severability.** If any term, condition or provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will nevertheless continue in full force and effect, and shall not be affected, impaired or invalidated in any way.
28. **Assignment.** The obligations of Consultant pursuant to this Agreement shall not be assigned by Consultant.
29. **Provisions Required By Law Deemed Inserted.** Each and every provision of law and clause required by law to be inserted in this Agreement shall be deemed to be inserted herein and this Agreement shall be read and enforced as though it were included therein.

30. **Authority to Bind Parties.** Neither party in the performance of any and all duties under this Agreement, except as otherwise provided in this Agreement, has any authority to bind the other to any agreements or undertakings.
31. **Captions and Interpretations.** Paragraph headings in this Agreement are used solely for convenience, and shall be wholly disregarded in the construction of this Agreement. No provision of this Agreement shall be interpreted for or against a party because that party or its legal representative drafted such provision, and this Agreement shall be construed as if jointly prepared by the Parties.
32. **Calculation of Time.** For the purposes of this Agreement, "days" refers to calendar days unless otherwise specified.
33. **Signature Authority.** Each party has the full power and authority to enter into and perform this Agreement, and the person signing this Agreement on behalf of each Party has been properly authority and empowered to enter into this Agreement.
34. **Counterparts.** This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which shall be deemed an original. A facsimile or electronic signature shall be deemed to be the equivalent of the actual original signature. All counterparts so executed shall constitute one Agreement binding all the Parties hereto.

Incorporation of Recitals and Exhibits. The Recitals and each exhibit attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

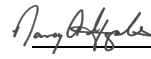

EXHIBIT A
DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED BY CONSULTANT

Consultant's entire Proposal is **not** made part of this Agreement.

MS Nursing Students in Arizona State University's NUR 509 course participate in a precepted clinical practicum focused on clinical prevention and population health within a healthcare or community-based setting. Under the supervision of a qualified preceptor, students complete approximately 45 clinical hours engaging in direct care and population-focused activities, including the implementation of evidence-based, culturally and linguistically appropriate prevention interventions and health promotion strategies. Students collaborate with interprofessional teams, utilize health information technologies, and apply epidemiological data and concepts such as social determinants of health to support individuals, families and populations. In partnership with the preceptor, students develop and carry out a learning plan, evaluate the effectiveness of interventions, and engage in ongoing self-assessment and reflection to support their professional development.

STATUS OF CONSULTANT, DISTRICT, AND CONSULTANT STUDENTS

The parties expressly understand and agree that CONSULTANT's students participating in a precepted clinical practicum in District schools pursuant to this Agreement are doing so for educational purposes only, and such students are not considered employees or volunteers of either CONSULTANT or District for any purpose, including, but not limited to, compensation for services, welfare and pension benefits, or workers' compensation insurance. CONSULTANT will immediately notify appropriate District administration if CONSULTANT has knowledge or suspects any professional or ethical violations by CONSULTANT's student placed in the school. It is the responsibility of CONSULTANT to provide written notice to its student participants of the provisions of this Section.
